Admit it: Your family as problems
Gen 27:1-28:11

"When Isaac was old and his eyes were so weak that he could no longer see, he called for Esau his older son and said to him, 'My son.' 'Here I am,' he answered. Isaac said, 'I am now an old man and don't know the day of my death. Now then, get your weapons — your quiver and bow — and go out to the open country to hunt some wild game for me. Prepare me the kind of tasty food I like and bring it to me to eat, so that I may give you my blessing before I die.' Now Rebekah was listening as Isaac spoke to his son Esau. When Esau left for the open country to hunt game and bring it back, Rebekah said to her son Jacob, 'Look, I overheard your father say to your brother Esau, 'Bring me some game and prepare me some tasty food to eat, so that I may give you my blessing in the presence of the LORD before I die.' ' Now, my son, listen carefully and do what I tell you: ' ...Then Rebekah took the best clothes of Esau her older son, which she had in the house, and put them on her younger son Jacob...He went to his father and said, 'My father.' 'Yes, my son,' he answered. 'Who is it?' Jacob said to his father, 'I am Esau your firstborn. I have done as you told me. Please sit up and eat some of my game so that you may give me your blessing.' ...Then Isaac said to Jacob, 'Come near so I can touch you, my son, to know whether you really are my son Esau or not.' Jacob went close to his father Isaac, who touched him and said, 'The voice is the voice of Jacob, but the hands are the hands of Esau.' He did not recognize him, for his hands were hairy like those of his brother Esau; so he blessed him.' 'Are you really my son Esau?' he asked. 'I am,' he replied... 'Come here, my son, and kiss me.' So he went to him and kissed him. When

Isaac caught the smell of his clothes, he blessed him and said, 'Ah, the smell of my son is like the smell of a field that the LORD has blessed. May God give you of heaven's dew'...After Isaac finished blessing him and Jacob had scarcely left his father's presence, his brother Esau came in from hunting....His father Isaac asked him, 'Who are you?' 'I am your son,' he answered, 'your firstborn, Esau. ...Bless me — me too, my father!' ...Esau said to his father, 'Do you have only one blessing, my father? Bless me too, my father!' Then Esau wept aloud".


