Growing in the virtue of Chastity

Numbers 11:1-35 - Kibroth Hataavah

“Whoever commits adultery with a woman lacks _____; he who does so destroys his own soul.”
Proverbs 6:32-33 NKJV

“Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous.” Hebrews 13:4 ESV

Chastity is sexual purity in _____

We think of chastity as passive restraint; it is instead a positive, active lifestyle marked by courage and self-control; it embraces moral wholesomeness, sets boundaries, and seeks purity in a permissive world. Chastity outside of marriage means abstinence; within marriage, it means exclusiveness. When

couples say “I do” to one another, they’re saying _____ to everyone else. Marital love is a commitment to fidelity/monogamy.

Job declared, “I have made a covenant with my eyes not to look lustfully at a girl” (31:1).


“...all who belong to Christ have crucified the flesh with its passions and desire.” Galatians 5:24

“You have heard that it was said, ‘Do not commit adultery. But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart. If your right eye causes you to sin, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to go into hell.’” Matthew 5:27-30

“No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it. I Corinthians 10:13 NKJV

“We may, indeed, be sure that perfect chastity—like perfect charity—will not be attained by any merely human efforts. You must ask for God’s help. Even when you have done so, it may seem to for a long time that no help, or less help than you need, is being given. Never mind. After each failure, ask forgiveness, pick yourself up, and try again. Very often what God first helps us towards is not the virtue itself but just this power of always trying again. For however important chastity (or courage, or truthfulness, or any other virtue) may be, this process trains us in habits of the soul which are more important still. It cures our illusions about ourselves and

teaches us to depend on God. We learn, on the one hand, that we cannot trust ourselves even in our best moments, and, on the other, that we need not despair even in our worst, for our failures are forgiven. The only fatal thing is to sit down content with anything less than perfection.” — C.S. Lewis
