I Deserve Rejection but He gave me Acceptance


“He does not treat us as our sins deserve...” Ps. 103:10

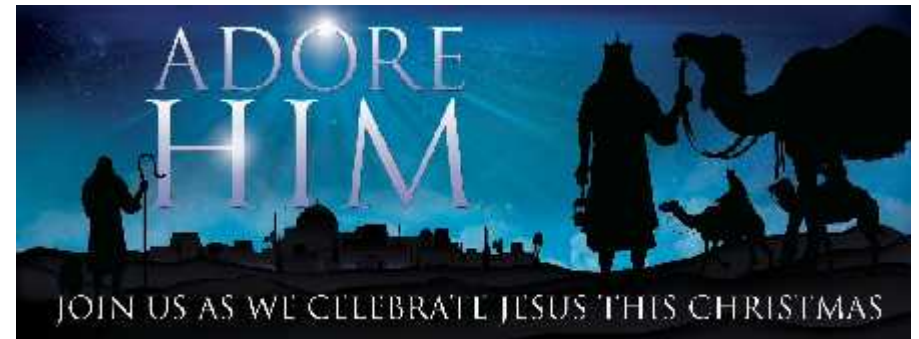
