In a spiritually confused world we will bring the truth that there is only one way to know God, and that is through Jesus Christ, the Savior of the world.


### ONE COMMISSION

\_\_\_\_\_ could be best described as *superiority* · *supremacy* · *greatness* · *excellence* · *distinction*.

*Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, <sup>2</sup> To God's holy people in Colossae, the faithful brothers and sisters in Christ: Grace and peace to you from God our Father. <sup>3</sup> We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, <sup>4</sup> because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all God's people— <sup>5</sup> the faith and love that spring from the hope stored up for you in heaven and about which you have already heard in the true message of the gospel <sup>6</sup> that has come to you. In the same way, the gospel is bearing fruit and growing throughout the whole world—just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and truly understood God's grace.*

<sup>9</sup> For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have **not stopped praying for you.** We continually ask God to fill you with the **knowledge of his will** through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, <sup>10</sup> so that **you may live a life worthy** of the Lord and **please him** in every way: **bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God,** <sup>11</sup> **being strengthened** with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great **endurance and patience,** <sup>12</sup> and giving **joyful thanks** to the Father, who has **qualified you** to share in the **inheritance** of his holy people in the kingdom of light. <sup>13</sup> For **he has rescued us** from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, <sup>14</sup> in whom we have **redemption, the forgiveness of sins.**
