The Parable of the Shrewd Manager: Luke 16:1-13

Jesus said, "There once was a rich man who enlisted a manager to take care of his property. But the manager was accused of wasting his master's possessions, so the Owner called him in and said, 'You must now give me an account of your stewardship and report what you've done with what I entrusted to you because your time as a manager is ending!' The manager thought, 'What am I going to do now? I'm losing my job but I'm not strong enough to dig ditches and I'm too proud to beg! I know what I'll do - so that after I lose my job, I'll have plenty of friends to take care of me!' So he called in everybody who was in debt to his master. He asked the first man, 'How much do you owe my master?' '800 gallons of olive oil,' he replied. The manager said, 'OK. Tear up that bill, and write a new bill that says you only owe 400 gallons. 'Next, the manager found another debtor and asked, 'How much do YOU owe?' '1000 bushels of wheat,' he replied. The manager said, 'OK, change your bill to say you only own 800.'" Now when the Master heard what the dishonest manager had done, he still praised his shrewdness. For worldly people are more shrewd in handling their affairs than are those who belong to the light." verses 1-8

"I tell you, use worldly wealth to gain friends for yourselves, so that when it is gone, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings. Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much. So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly

wealth, who will trust you with true riches? And if you have not been trustworthy with someone else's property, who will give you property of your own? No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money." Verses 9-13
