LOVE, RESPECT, HONOR, FORGIVE, LEGACY
June 10, 2018

EACH WORD in the Fab 5 is taken from **Ephesians 5**, the most significant chapter in the **Bible on the family**. All 5 are key to relationships. All 5 are universal in their application. **All family members are to love, respect, honor, forgive and help to leave a godly legacy.**

But at the same time God also singles out some family members and specifically commands them to focus on one of these words... **As if to say "I really want you to do this... the family really needs you not to neglect this... in order for your role in the family to be the key role I have designed it to be- you need to put an extra emphasis on this word."**

“Husbands, love your wives [seek the highest good for her and surround her with a caring, unselfish love], just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her.”(Ephesians 5:25 Amplified)

I. Love Your Wife by _____

“For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior.”(Ephesians 5:23)

II. Love your Wife by _____

“Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her” (Ephesians 5:25)

III. Love your Wife by _____

“to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.” (Ephesians 5:26–27)

IV. Love your Wife by _____

“In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, because we are members of his body.” (Ephesians 5:28–30)

V. Love your wife by _____

“Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.” This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church.” (Ephesians 5:31–32)

“Let the wife see that she _____, and reverences her husband- that she notices him, regards him, honors him, prefers him, esteems him and that she defers to him, praises him and loves and admires him exceedingly.”(Eph. 5:33 Amplified)

“Wives, submit to your own husbands as to the Lord.”(Eph. 5:22)

“Just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything” (Ephesians 5:24)

Christ, although equal to God, voluntarily submitted to His Father:
