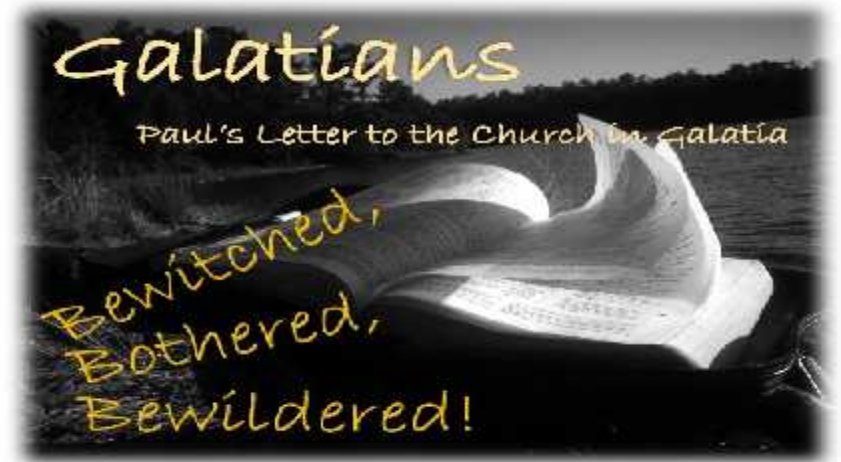

## Part One - *Bondservant*

The book of Galatians derives its title from a region in Turkey. It is one of 13 inspired letters Paul addressed to Gentile congregations or his fellow workers. This letter was written between 47 and 60 A.D.

Paul wrote this letter to counter false teachers who were undermining the central Christian doctrine of justification by faith, they spread their dangerous teaching that Gentiles must first become Jewish proselytes and submit to all the Mosaic law before they could become Christians. The Church at Galatia had been **bewitched** into disobeying the truth, had been **bothered** by false teachers, and were so quick to embrace new and unorthodox ideas that Paul was **bewildered** by their behavior. **Paul's antidote to their spiritual confusion was to remind them of the true gospel of Jesus Christ.**

### Chapter One

"Paul, an apostle (not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father who raised Him from the dead), **2** and all the brethren who are with me, To the churches of Galatia: **3** Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ, **4** who gave Himself for our sins, that He might

deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, **5** to whom *be* glory forever and ever. Amen.

**6** I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, **7** which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. **8** But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. **9** As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.

**10** For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ.

**11** But I make known to you, brethren that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man. **12** For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught *it*, but *it came* through the revelation of Jesus Christ.

**13** For you have heard of my former conduct in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God beyond measure and *tried to* destroy it. **14** And I advanced in Judaism beyond many of my contemporaries in my own nation, being more exceedingly zealous for the traditions of my fathers.

**15** But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb and called *me* through His grace, **16** to reveal His Son in me, that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately confer with flesh and blood, **17** nor did I go up to

Jerusalem to those *who were* apostles before me; but I went to Arabia, and returned again to Damascus.

**18** Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter and remained with him fifteen days. **19** But I saw none of the other apostles except James, the Lord's brother. **20** (Now *concerning* the things which I write to you, indeed, before God, I do not lie.)

**21** Afterward I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia. **22** And I was unknown by face to the churches of Judea which *were* in Christ. **23** But they were hearing only, 'He who formerly persecuted us now preaches the faith which he once *tried to* destroy.' **24** And they glorified God in me."
